FROM THE RECTOR'S DESK

Greetings! We start off November with the Feast of All Saints on November 1, which we celebrate on the first Sunday after. All Saints' Day, one of the principal feasts of the Episcopal Church, is the day we remember the saints, known and unknown. In the New Testament, the term "saints" refers to the entire Christian community. Over the centuries, however, the word "saint" has come to mean people of "heroic sanctity."

So, beginning in the tenth century, the church designated November 2 to remember all departed Christians. It's a tradition in many churches to take time in the All Saints' liturgy to specifically recall the names of persons who have died in the previous year, a custom we observe at Trinity. Since November 1 falls on Sunday only every five or six years, it's the custom of the Episcopal Church, and Trinity, to "transfer" the observance of All Saints' Sunday to the Sunday closest to, but after, November 1.

So, what is the message of All Saints? Celebrations of the lives of the saints have occurred, in some form, in the life of the church since the early days, with historical mentions going back as far as 270 CE. For a church beleaguered with great persecution, such a time of remembrance of those who faithfully professed Christ, even to torture and death, must have been a great encouragement. Symbolizing the shining robes of the martyrs, the liturgical color for All Saints is white. As we give thanks for the saints of the church, it is also a time to remember that "mystic sweet communion with those whose rest is won," and the continual work of the Holy Spirit in building up "one holy, catholic, and apostolic church."

On this All Saints' Sunday, I will mark my tenth year as your rector. As I reflect on the saints of our congregation that have passed in my time with you, I am deeply grateful for their faithfulness to God and our church.

I am grateful for each of you as well.
